Topic 1: Who Is God?

One of the most important things you can know as a new believer is who God is. He is not simply a higher power or a distant force — He is a personal, living God who knows you by name and loves you deeply. Here are scriptures that reveal His nature and character.

God Is Eternal and Self-Existent

Psalm 90:2

"Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God."

Exodus 3:14

"And God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM.' And He said, 'Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you.'"

Revelation 1:8

"'I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,' says the Lord, 'who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.'"

God Is All-Knowing, All-Powerful, and Everywhere Present

Psalm 139:1–4

"O Lord, You have searched me and known me. You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off. You comprehend my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word on my tongue, but behold, O Lord, You know it altogether."

Jeremiah 32:17

"Ah, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You."

Psalm 139:7–8

"Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; if I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there."

God Is Love

1 John 4:8

"He who does not love does not know God, for God is love."

John 3:16

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

Romans 8:38–39

"For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Is Holy and Just

Isaiah 6:3

"And one cried to another and said: 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!'"

Deuteronomy 32:4

"He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He."

God Is a Trinity — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

Matthew 28:19

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

2 Corinthians 13:14

"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen."

"I and My Father are one."

God Is Good and Faithful

Psalms 100:5

"For the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations."

Lamentations 3:22–23

"Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness."

Numbers 23:19

"God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?"

Topic 2: What Is the Power of God?

God's power is unlimited and available to those who believe. As a new Christian, it is important to know that the same power that raised Jesus from the dead lives inside you. You are not on your own — you have access to the greatest power in the universe.

God's Power Is Limitless

Ephesians 3:20

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us."

Luke 1:37

"For with God nothing will be impossible."

42:2

"I know that You can do everything, and that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You."

The Power of God for Salvation

Romans 1:16

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek."

1 Corinthians 1:18

"For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God."

The Resurrection Power Living in You

Ephesians 1:19–20

"And what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places."

Romans 8:11

"But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you."

Philippians 4:13

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

God's Power Through the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Zechariah 4:6

"So he answered and said to me: 'This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the Lord of hosts."

2 Timothy 1:7

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

God's Power in Healing and Deliverance

Acts 10:38

"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

Psalms 62:11

"God has spoken once, twice I have heard this: that power belongs to God."

Isaiah 40:29

"He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength."

God's Power Displayed in Creation

Genesis 1:1

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

Psalm 33:6

"By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth."

3: What Is Our Identity in Christ?

Many new believers struggle with understanding who they are now that they have accepted Christ. The world may have told you one thing about yourself, but God says something completely different. Your true identity is found in what God says about you — not in your past, your failures, or what others have said.

You Are a New Creation

2 Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Galatians 2:20

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

You Are a Child of God

John 1:12

"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name."

Romans 8:15–16

"For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, 'Abba, Father.' The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God."

1 John 3:1

"Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him."

You Are Chosen and Beloved

1 Peter 2:9

"But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."

Ephesians 1:4–5

"Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will."

Colossians 3:12

"Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering."

You Are Forgiven and Righteous**2 Corinthians 5:21**

"For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."

Colossians 1:13–14

"He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins."

Romans 8:1

"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit."

You Are Loved Unconditionally**Romans 5:8**

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Jeremiah 31:3

"The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: 'Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.'"

You Are More Than a Conqueror**Romans 8:37**

"Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us."

1 John 4:4

"You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

John 15:15

"No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you."

Topic 4: What Authority Have We Been Given in Christ?

When Jesus rose from the dead, He was given all authority in heaven and on earth — and He has shared that authority with every believer. You are not powerless against sin, sickness, or the enemy. Through Christ, you have been given real spiritual authority to use in your everyday life.

Jesus Has All Authority**Matthew 28:18**

"And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, 'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.'"

Ephesians 1:21–22

"Far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church."

We Share in Christ's Authority

Luke 10:19

"Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

Ephesians 2:6

"And raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus."

Mark 16:17–18

"And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

Authority Over the Enemy

James 4:7

"Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you."

Colossians 2:15

"Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it."

1 Peter 5:8–9

"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith."

Authority Through the Name of Jesus

Philippians 2:9–10

"Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth."

John 14:13–14

"And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it."

Acts 3:6

"Then Peter said, 'Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk.'"

Authority Through Prayer

Matthew 16:19

"And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Matthew 18:18

"Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

1 John 5:14–15

"Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him."

Authority Through the Word of God**Hebrews 4:12**

"For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

Revelation 12:11

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death."

Topic 5: Our Rights and Privileges as Children of God

Because you are a child of God, you have been given an inheritance in His kingdom. These are not things you have to earn — they belong to you because of what Jesus has already done. Learn to know your benefits and walk in them boldly!

Eternal Life**John 3:16**

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."

John 10:28

"And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand."

Romans 6:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Access to the Father Through Prayer**Ephesians 3:12**

"In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him."

Hebrews 4:16

"Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

Matthew 7:7–8

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."

God's Provision and Supply**Philippians 4:19**

"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

Psalms 23:1

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."

Matthew 6:31–33

"Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."

2 Corinthians 9:8

"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work."

Divine Healing and Health**Isaiah 53:5**

"But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed."

1 Peter 2:24

"Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness — by whose stripes you were healed."

Psalms 103:2–3

"Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases."

3 John 1:2

"Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers."

Peace That Surpasses Understanding**John 14:27**

"Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

Philippians 4:6–7

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

Isaiah 26:3

"You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You."

The Holy Spirit as Our Guide and Helper

John 14:16–17

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever — the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you."

John 16:13

"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come."

Romans 8:26

"Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

Protection and Safety

Psalm 91:1–2

"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge and my fortress; my God, in Him I will trust.'"

Psalm 91:11

"For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways."

Isaiah 54:17

"No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me, says the Lord."

2 Thessalonians 3:3

"But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one."

Joy and Abundant Life

John 10:10

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

Nehemiah 8:10

"Do not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

Psalm 16:11

"You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

Colossians 1:12

"Giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light."
